## Mare Pregnancy Checklist

Mare: Example Mare

Owner: Example Owner

Last Ovulation Date Post Breeding: 3/10/2020

• Estimated **Due Date** (340 days of gestation): **2/13/2021**

\*if mare starts **bagging up/ dripping milk** any time before 1/24/2021  
please consult a veterinarian as the mare may have placentitis and be trying to abort foal

• Mare is Caslicked (\*sewed) Yes No Uncertain

If **YES** Caslicks should be OPENED (\*un-sewed) by: 1/22/2021

If **UNCERTAIN** mare's vulva should be checked to see if Caslicks is present by: 1/22/2021

### • Routine Vaccinations\*\*

"Prodigy" or "Pneumobort K" (Equine Herpes Virus-1)

5 months: 8/7/2020

7 months: 10/6/2020

9 months: 12/5/2020

10 months: 1/4/2021

"4-way" (Tetanus/East&West Encephalitis/Equine Influenza/Rhinopneumonitis), West Nile, Rabies)

\*\*Any vaccines given to a pregnant mare must be a "**KILLED VACCINE**". Please consult with your veterinarian if you have any questions. Other vaccines that may be beneficial to give your mare are: Rotavirus, Botulism, **Killed-Strangles**, etc. Please consult a veterinarian if you have any questions about these vaccines.

### • Deworming:

Return to regular routine after > 50 days of pregnancy: 4/29/2020

At time of foaling deworm with an Ivermectin product. **DO NOT** deworm with Quest® products

• **Blood draw** (mare) For **NI Screen** (Jaundice Foal Disease) at: 1/29/2021
